Checkout Guidelines

Borrowers

- UA students, faculty, and staff ONLY
- Must have valid University ID Card
- Must sign a Loan Agreement for any extended checkout

Checkout Information

- Checkout is through the main Circulation Desk at Mullins Library & the Student Technology Center in the Union.
- Checkout is on a first-come first-serve basis with no reserves or renewals.
- Loan period is 3 hours or 48 hours, depending on agreement.
- Laptops can be used anywhere.

Fines

- Overdue laptops: \$10.00 per hour
- Borrower is responsible for loss or damage
- Replacement charge of \$3,000 may be charged for loss or damage.

- E-mail the work (files) to your e-mail account.
- FTP the files to your comp.uark.edu account.

- Do not plug in or unplug an external device unless computer and external device are turned off.
